

## WHAT ARE THE VKRP RESOURCES?

- Strategies that teachers can implement to foster their student’s **math** and **socio-emotional skills**.
- Designed to **support** specific students or classrooms that do not demonstrate the level of socio-emotional and/or math skills one would expect for Kindergarten entry<sup>1</sup>.
- **In-Depth guides** that include the following sections:

  - Example(s)

  - Steps to implement the strategy

The level of expected math and socio-emotional skills were determined both theoretically (i.e., utilizing current developmental literature) and empirically (i.e., through examination of pilot data collected across the state of Virginia in the fall of 2015).
